Setup:

1. Shuffle the blue topic cards and place in a face-down deck.
2. Shuffle the orange question cards and deal six (6) face-up in the middle of the table.

How to Play:

Players will take turns being the guesser and will try to correctly guess the word by carefully selecting questions to ask the players. Each round is played as follows:

1. Select a Word [Everyone except the Guesser]

The guesser closes their eyes while all other players look at a topic card and silently agree on one of the words to use for the round.

2. Ask a Question [The Guesser]

The guesser chooses one of the six question cards on the table, and asks each player the question, in any order they desire. Note the three types of question cards below.

3. Answer the Question [Everyone except the Guesser]

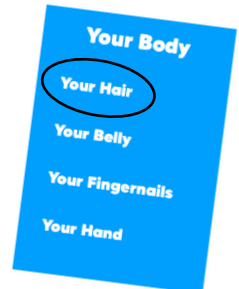
Players must answer the question honestly, while aiming to make it challenging to guess the word being described. Be clever with your answers!

4. Make a Guess [The Guesser]

After each question is answered, the Guesser can make a Guess.

- Incorrect Guess: draw a new question card and continue asking questions (repeat #2-4 for up to 5 questions)
- Correct Guess: Guesser earns points based on questions asked

If the Guesser does not correctly guess after asking 5 questions, all other players earn 1 point that round.

Game End:

Once all players have played as the Guesser twice, players add their points earned from each round, and the highest overall score wins the game!
